Many teachers have participated in this work and all of these have contributed something of value to the procedure now in use. Acknowledgments cannot be made here to all from whom valuable help has been received; but especial mention should be made of the initial program laid out in 1900 by Doctors Barker and Kyes when they were suddenly confronted with the problem of teaching the anatomy of the brain to a very large class of medical students with practically no equipment and a very limited amount of anatomical material (see the paper by Barker and Kyes cited in the appended Bibliography). The large measure of success which they attained should encourage other teachers whose laboratory equipment is inadequate. Later Doctors Donaldson and Hardesty elaborated this course, and when the direction of the work was assumed by the senior author in 1907 he received valuable assistance from Doctor...
