Many farmers in the Yakima River Basin are converting to sprinkler or drip irrigation systems that are considerably more costly than either flood or furrow irrigation methods. However, grass-lined ditches may be an effective sediment reduction (total P source) method in the Klamath Basin. The estimated effectiveness of grass-lined ditches alone was up to 45 (U. S. D. A. Soil Conservation Service, 1992). Animal Manure as a Source of Phosphorus in the Watershed Solid waste is usually a mixture of dung, urine, and undigested vegetable matter. Cattle deposit wastes throughout the pasture in a variable fashion, but a greater density of wastes may accumulate near watering and feeding locations, or in loafing areas such as the riparian zones near streams where vegetation is plentiful and shade is available.
