

I am, Gentlemen, your most obedient, And very humble servant, Josiah Bartlett. To the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives, to be communicated. The repose which he anticipated, so inestimable to a man, the better part of whose life had been consumed amid the toils and troubles of the revolution, and the dissensions which preceded it, was destined,...
